*Bible study groups will again be starting up. We invite you to consider these possibilities and get involved if possible.*

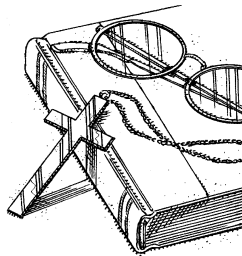

### **Rosedale Mennonite Missions' 2010 Missions Day Offering**

In addition to the \$77,000 RMM received Sunday morning at Conference for the annual ***Missions Day Offering***, we have received other gifts and pledges that bring our total to \$269,900 as of August 20. This includes a record breaking Ride for Missions income of \$55,600. While we reached only 61% of our special 2010 goal of \$440,000, it's still our highest ever ***Missions Day Offering*** total. If all pledges are fulfilled, almost \$30,000 will go towards the Branching Out Campaign. Contributions toward the MDO continue throughout

the year, so any gifts we receive by December 31, earmarked for the ***Missions Day Offering***, will bring us even closer to the goal.
