The Mifflin Juniata Department of Human Services invites you to participate in the 2020 Point-in-time Unsheltered Count on Wednesday, January 22.

Participants should meet at the East End Coffee Shop, 18 E. Market St. Lewistown, at 5:30pm for a brief mandatory training. The homeless survey will take place from 6-7:30pm.

This is a humanitarian outreach and all of the numbers collected do a great service to help get funds into our local area to be sure that we can provide services to help anyone who becomes homeless.

In our rural area, while we do not usually have homeless living on street corners like in urban areas, we do have people moving from family homes to friend's homes; these are people with no fixed address. We have had people living out of tents, abandoned homes, vehicles and storage sheds in our area. Volunteers will be looking for homeless persons and if any are found they will offer to make arrangements to get them into a shelter that evening.
