A weekend of services commemorating the 500th Anniversary of Anabaptism will be held May 16-18, 2025 at the Allensville Mennonite Church, Allensville, PA. Meetings will continue on Saturday evening at 7:00 and Sunday morning at 9:15 and 10:40, traveling through Anabaptist history and concluding with how Anabaptism speaks to our broken world in the 21st Century. All are welcome to attend. Allensville Mennonite will host a carry-in meal following Sunday's service and anyone planning to stay for this meal is invited to bring a hot or cold dish to share.
