

The Mifflin County Amish-Mennonite Historical Society's Fall Heritage Day will be held on Saturday, September 27, 2025 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. The event will be located on the corner of Main and Walnut Streets, Belleville. Both the Heritage Center and the Heritage House will be open for tours and browsing, and new this year will be Putt-Putt's Homemade Ice Cream, churned on site with a 1923 hit-and-miss engine. There will be many demonstrations on the lawn, including spinning wool and rug braiding, corn shelling, drying apples, blacksmithing, woodworking, hand pressed cider making, Native American artifacts and more! Everyone is invited to join us!

For the month of September, Operation Christmas Child will be collecting games. There is also an Amazon Wish List set up for items needed for our packing party (date will be announced at a later time). There is a flyer on the bulletin board in the foyer with a QR code. Exciting plans are underway as our youth group prepares for a mission trip to the Dominican Republic during Holy Week 2026. This opportunity will include teens, young adults, and adult chaperones from our church, all working together to serve through King's Quest, a mission organization based in Juniata County. While in the DR, the group will assist with a children's ministry, sharing God's love and building relationships through service and outreach. As they prepare spiritually and logistically, we ask the congregation to keep this team in your prayers — for safety, unity, and meaningful impact.
