Due to this change, our worship services for these weeks will begin at 10am. We will resume our regular Sunday School classes on Sun., Sept.13 at 9:15am & our Worship Services at 10:30am.

As elders of Mt. View, we would like to recommend the following changes to our church's constitution. These changes are in regard to Article 5, Section 1, Letter A of the Elder Leadership Team under membership and organization. Currently, our church constitution states: "1. The elder leadership team shall consist of the Pastor, Associate Pastor, and four elders." Recommended change: "1. The elder leadership team should consist of the Pastor, Associate Pastor (if applicable), and four elders." Currently, our church constitution states: "3. Each elder shall serve a four-year term. An elder may be eligible to serve again after one year off of the elder leadership team." Recommended change: "3. Each elder shall serve a four-year term. An elder may be eligible to serve again upon being nominated & then voted on in the Annual Church Business Meeting." These changes are in regard to either compliance with the constitution or in extending the opportunity to serve. We will entertain these changes after our service on Sun., May 17 during a church business meeting. If you have any questions or concerns about these changes, please contact one of our elders.
